Installation Instructions

1. Copy the SR202 file to your vstplugins folder (on the PC platform the program file will be a .DLL file, called "SR202.dll"). On the Mac the file will be called "SR202" and should have a VST-style icon.

v1.0 Known Issues

1. When the SR202 is loaded into a VST Instrument rack sometimes the left channel volume appears to be attenuated, despite the fader being at unity gain and the pan hard left. This is a bug in VST3.7, not in the SR202. To rectify, "jiggle" the pan gadget of the offending track, then set back to maximum. VST3.7r1 does not appear to correct this bug.
2. Background graphics do not update whilst a knob is being turned in many hosts (Logic Audio, Orion, Fruity Loops). This is not a bug in the SR202 but the host software itself, and is not harmful.
3. Certain host software have limitations which mean that the full functionality of SR202 may not be available:

Cubase up to 3.7 Cubasis prior to v3	Cannot save sample data along with song
Logic Audio (all versions)	Cannot save sample data along with song Does not support multiple outputs
Magix Music Maker G6	Cannot save sample data along with song Does not support multiple outputs
Fruity Loops	Does not support multiple outputs
Buzz/Psycle	Does not support multiple outputs
