

IMPORTANT INFO FOR MAC USERS

Some macOS users may encounter a “This app is damaged” error when attempting to open Guitar Station. This issue stems from GateKeeper, macOS’s security feature that restricts app access to those downloaded from the App Store or verified Apple developers (the “Anywhere” option is hidden by default).

How to solve this issue:

1. When the error appears, go to **System Preferences > Security & Privacy > General**.
2. You should see a message at the bottom saying, "Guitar Station was blocked from opening because it is not from an identified developer."
3. Click **Open Anyway** to grant permission.
4. Confirm when prompted, and the app should open.

When you open the app for the first time, you’ll be prompted to allow access to the Microphone. This permission is essential for the app to function correctly on the latest version of macOS.

If you choose not to allow access, you may encounter issues that can be resolved by enabling permission through your Privacy & Security settings. Close Guitar Station and launch it again.

Once you've granted the required permissions, you won't be asked again.
